Program Overview

- Approximately \$300 million annually (50% of the Diesel Excise Tax)
- SB 1 language "to be expended on corridor-based freight projects nominated by local agencies and the state"
- Establish Accountability Performance Measures
- Proposed Trailer Bill language provides more guidance



Trailer Bill Language

- Combines the federal National Highway Freight Program funds with the TCEP funds into a single program.
- Evaluate potential economic and noneconomic benefits to the state's economy, environment, and public health.
- Include Disadvantaged Communities measures
- Necessitates an update of the CFMP project list



Proposed Schedule

(dependent on timing of Trailer Bill approval)

- Workshops June thru November 2017
- Draft Guidelines December 6, 2017
- Guideline Adoption January 31, 2018
- Applications Due March 2, 2018
- Release Staff Recommendations April 30, 2018
- Program Adoption May 16, 2018
